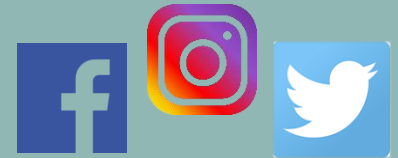

The 2022 Golf Season is Coming!

Owen's Practice Green

With many people starting the winter season in preparation for the 2022 season, you must formulate a training plan to optimize performance. Looking at the statistical data, many people put emphasis on the wrong areas of the game. When it comes to three areas of the game (Off-the-Tee, Approach, and Putting) the biggest variance within the strokes gained metrics will surprise you:

PGA TOUR 2021 AVERAGES

Off-the-Tee:

Average Strokes Gained – 0.030
Variance – 2.409

Approach:

Average Strokes Gained – 0.052
Variance – 2.771

Putting:

Average Strokes Gained – 0.027
Variance – 2.025

Interpreting these results, you can tell that with the highest variance and the lowest number of strokes gained average that you should try to focus your practice routines around putting and approach shots.

PUTTING: Start working on line and pace. Try experimenting with hitting putts from the same spot with the same line and different paces.

APPROACH: Try using the same club for 100 yds and in and experiment with backswing length for distance control.

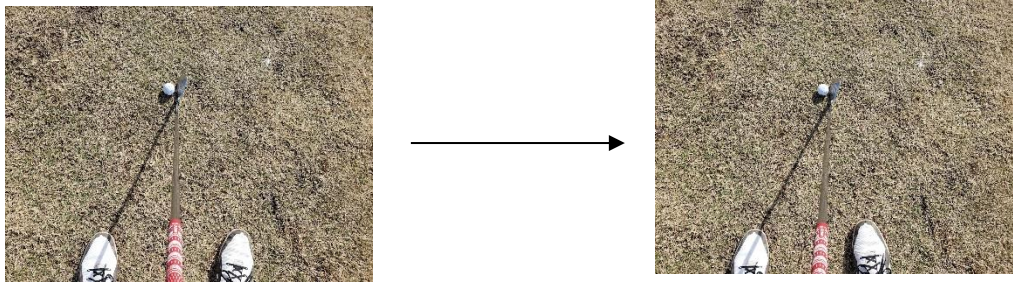
Develop Skills in Classes - We offer weekly group classes for you to attend that are educational and fun.

ADVICE FROM A PRO

If you're having trouble getting depth in your backswing or don't understand how to utilize your hips in the swing, try flaring out your trail foot (right foot for right-handed golfers) at address. This will open up that hip and allow you to feel a wider turn.
